ACHIEVE Health Literacy Program – Denise Sheffield, RN was the February Speaker covering Heart Health and the American Heart Association's Essential 8. There were 34 participants in attendance. As part of the session, Denise challenged the group to become knowledgeable about where AEDs are located on campus, and how to use them. She also discussed Damar Hamlin's #3 for Heart CPR challenge. A communication was sent as a follow up to all participants, as well as information posted in the announcements.
